All motor vehicles entering New Zealand must undergo a quarantine border inspection and be assessed for Goods and Services Tax by the Customs Department. In order to complete these clearances on your behalf we require the following information. - Copy of residence visa (first time immigrants only)

Note Before a vehicle can be driven on the road in New Zealand it must be inspected by a Transport Services Delivery Agent for compliance with legal safety requirements. Repairs and or modifications may be necessary before a Warrant of Fitness is issued. The vehicle must then be registered with the Land Transport Safety Authority.
