4.0 Storage Charges. – CONTACT WALKERS

4.1 Storage Rental: A\$POA per 100lbs net per month or part thereof. A minimum of 1000lbs net applies.

4.2 Storage Handling: A\$POA per 100lbs net (cover in to & out of store). A minimum of 1000lbs net applies.

5.0 Australian Quarantine Inspection Charges. – CONTACT WALKERS

5.1 The Australian Quarantine examination fees are not included in the above and are normally charged directly to the client unless your instructions suggest otherwise. For regulations on AQIS, please refer to the following link:

5.2 Inspection charges will be as follows:

- FCL Consignments: 20' Containers: \$POA 40' Containers: \$TBA
- Groupage consignments: \$POA per 100lbs net (Minimum charge \$TBA)
- Air & LCL Consignments: \$POA per 100lbs net (Minimum charge \$TBA)
- Motor cars/Bikes (per vehicle): \$TBA flat rate
- Baggage: \$TBA per consignment

5.2.1 Note that these charges cover a normal AQIS inspection, they do not allow for a detailed inspection, nor do they allow for any treatments or destructions as may be ordered by AQIS.

6.0 Australian Port Handling Charges

6.1 Port Handling charges are not included in the above rates. These should always be pre-paid where possible. If not pre-paid then we will arrange payment but then we will invoice this back to you at cost, plus a 15% administration fee.

7.0 Rates include:

10 days free storage, from date of arrival
Normal customs clearances
Collection of consignment from terminal/wharf
Delivery up to first floor, or to store
Weekday deliver during normal working hours
Return of empty shipping containers
Complete unpacking & unwrapping, and
and placing on flat surfaces
Australian Goods & Services Tax (GST)

9.0 Australian Customs requirements and the paperwork we require

9.1 For us to service you and your clients requirements as efficiently as possible, please make sure that we receive the following documentation whenever you consign an import shipment to **Walkers World Wide**:-

- Your instructions detailing what services we are to provide and who to invoice
- A copy of our quotation
- A clear and legible, properly completed B534 (Unaccompanied effects statement)
- A copy of the personal details page of your clients passport, this must include the photograph and the visa, both must be clear and customs must be able to see the facial features in the photograph.
- A detailed descriptive inventory of the goods, written in English.

9.2 Due to the requirements of the Australian Customs electronic system, we must have all documents at least 4 days prior to the vessels arrival at its **first Australian port of call**.

10.0 Payment terms

10.1 Unless credit terms have previously been arranged via a credit application process, we ask that you send payment in full with the above paperwork.

12.0 Applicable Law and Dispute Resolution

12.1 The law which governs this agreement will be the law applicable in the place in which the agreement is made.

12.2 Disputes Notification of Dispute: If You or We consider that a dispute has arisen in relation to this agreement (either during the Services, or after they have been completed), written notice of the dispute will be given to the other party. Even if that notice is given, You and We must continue to perform any obligations outstanding by Us under the agreement.

12.3 Dispute Resolution: If You and We cannot resolve the dispute between Us, You are entitled to refer the dispute to an independent mediator or the Australian Furniture Removers Association (telephone +61 1800 671 806) which has procedures for dispute resolution, and We, AND You, will agree to be bound by the outcome of that referral.

13.0 Definitions in these conditions

13.1 “We” means Walkers Moving and Storage Pty Ltd Trading as Walkers World Wide ABN 70 010 176 002, and “Us” and “Our” have corresponding meanings.

13.2 “You” means the party entering into the agreement for Services with Us, and includes the party to whom Our invoice and this tariff are addressed and the party by whom the acceptance is signed, and “Your” has a corresponding meaning.

13.3 “Charges and Rates” means the whole of the work to be undertaken by Us in connection with the Goods including removal and (if applicable) storage.

13.4 “Goods” means all furniture and other effects which are to be the subject of the Charges and or Rates.

13.5 “Subcontractor or Accessorial Service” means any person other than one of Our employees who, under any agreement or arrangement with Us (whether directly or indirectly) performs or agrees to perform the whole or any part of the Services.

13.6 “A\$” means amount is quoted in Australian Dollars.

13.7 Words in the singular include the plural, and words in one or more genders include all genders.
